What the NAC OSCE is

The NAC OSCE is the clinical skills exam used in the Canadian IMG pathway. Encounters are longer than PLAB 2 (commonly around **11-minute** assessments with reading/transition time). Scenarios and management must follow **Canadian** guidelines, drug names and system context — not NICE/BNF.

What transfers • what does not

Transfers: structured history, ICE, explanation, empathy, timed spoken fluency, Learn → Practise → Review → Simulate. Dual AI Attempts (voice + text) apply on live practice — free = 3 + 3.

"BUT THE REAL EXAM HAS A HUMAN ACTOR..."

True — and everything the examiner marks is still produced by **you speaking**. Structure, fluency, signposting, empathy phrasing, time management: these are speaker-side skills. Candidates who arrive having done dozens of full spoken run-throughs consistently report the real encounter felt **easier** than practice — the hard part was already automatic.

DO NOT

Do not treat UK guidelines, drug names or pathways as NAC-ready. Re-map every management point to Canadian sources when NAC content launches.
